

NOVEMBER

13th: Sixth World Day of the Poor: “... Jesus’s words are clear: if we want life to triumph over death, and dignity to be redeemed from injustice, we need to follow Christ’s path of poverty, sharing our lives out of love, breaking the bread of our daily existence with our brothers and sisters, beginning with the least of them, those who lack the very essentials of life. This is the way to create equality, to free the poor from their misery and the rich from their vanity, and both from despair”. (Message of Pope Francis for the Sixth World Day of the Poor 2022)

16th: International Day for Tolerance: Tolerance is neither indulgence nor indifference. It is respect and appreciation of the rich variety of our world's cultures, our forms of expression, and our ways of being human. Tolerance recognizes the universal human rights and fundamental freedoms of others. People are naturally diverse; only tolerance can ensure the survival of mixed communities in every region of the globe.

25th: International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women

Nearly 1 in 3 women have been abused in their lifetime and the numbers rise in times of crisis. While pervasive, gender-based violence is not inevitable, stopping this violence starts with believing in survivors, adopting comprehensive and inclusive approaches that tackle the root causes, transforming harmful social norms, and empowering women and girls.

DECEMBER

2nd: International Day for the Abolition of Slavery. It is about raising awareness and reinforcing global efforts in combating the scourge of modern slavery, such as trafficking in persons, sexual exploitation, the worst forms of child labour, forced marriage, and the forced recruitment of children for use in armed conflict.

17th: Pope Francis’ 85th birthday. “Here is then a ‘magisterium of frailty’. Do not hide frailties, no. It is true, they are real and there is a magisterium of frailty, which old age is able to remind us of in a credible way for the whole span of human life. Do not hide old age, do not hide the frailty of old age. This is a teaching for all of us.” (Pope Francis, General Audience, June 2022)
