1st- 4th Season of Creation

This year we will unite around the theme, “Listen to the voice of Creation”

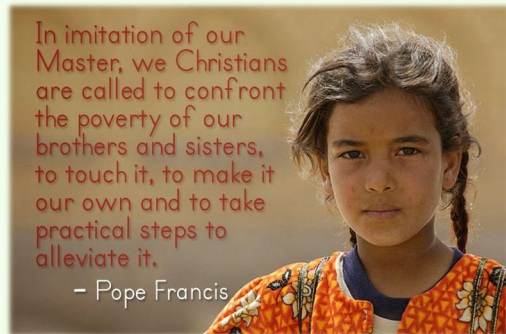
During the Covid-19 pandemic, many have become familiar with the concept of being muted in conversations. Many voices are muted in public discourse around climate change and the ethics of Earth-keeping. These are voices of those who suffer the impacts of climate change; voices of people who hold generational wisdom about how to live gratefully within the limits of the land. These are voices of a diminishing diversity of more-than-human species. It is the voice of the Earth. The 2022 Season of Creation theme raises awareness of our need to listen to the voice of creation.

Abolition of the Death Penalty

We pray that the death penalty, which attacks the dignity of the human person, may be legally abolished in every country.

10th World suicide prevention day: since it is one of the three leading causes of death among people in the economically productive age range of 14 to 44 years and the second cause of death among youth and adolescents age 15 to 19. WHO encourages the development of action plan against suicide.

We pray for courage and strength when people get into depression and become suicidal.



21st International Day of Peace: true peace entails much more than laying down arms. It requires the building of societies where all members feel that they can flourish. It involves creating a world in which people are treated equally, regardless of their race.

We pray that true peace may overcome any trace of violence or need to control and possess all.

October

A Church Open to Everyone

We pray for the Church; ever faithful to, and courageous in preaching the Gospel, may the Church be a community of solidarity, fraternity and welcome, always living in an atmosphere of synodality.

11th International day of the girl child: Nearly 1 in 4 girls aged 15–19 globally are not in education, employment or training, compared to 1 in 10 boys. We pray for the recognition of girls rights and the unique challenges they face around the world.

Over his pontificate, Pope Francis has made many gestures to give momentum to this desire to give women greater weight in the Church. The Pope’s *Evangelii gaudium* reads: “Demands that the legitimate rights of women be respected, based on the firm conviction that men and women are equal in dignity, present the Church with profound and challenging questions which cannot be lightly evaded” (104).

17th International day for the eradication of poverty: People living in poverty face increasingly difficult challenges and climate change, environmental degradation and rising food prices threaten their livelihoods and survival.

We pray that attention may be drawn to the importance to the eradication of poverty for building sustainable futures for all.
