¹Isabella Hart was the younger sister of Delphine Hart, she travelled to India in 1841 as a postulant, entered religious life in Calcutta. On some lists she is recorded as Isabella Hart, as she had not assumed a religious name for the voyage to India.

² A widow from Trinidad, she entered the novitiate in Rathfarnham in October 1844, and travelled to Mauritius in 1845 as a postulant. She was not professed and returned to Ireland.

³ Valentina Hutchinson was the younger sister of Ignatia Hutchinson, she travelled to Canada in 1847 as a postulant, entered religious life in Toronto. Throughout her life, she is referred to as both Valentina and Berchmans (her name in religious life) in surviving documentation, and on some lists is recorded as Valentina Hutchinson, as she had not assumed a religious name in time for her voyage to Canada.

⁵ Spelt 'Völeher' in the novitiate register, but this later spelling Volker seems to have been used thereafter.

⁶ Helen Hughes travelled to Australia in 1875 as a postulant, entered religious life in Ballarat. On some lists she is recorded as Helen Hughes, as she had not assumed a religious name for the voyage to Australia.

⁷ Margaret O'Brien travelled to Australia in 1875 as a postulant, entered religious life in Ballarat. On some lists she is recorded as Margaret O'Brien, as she had not assumed a religious name for the voyage to Australia.
